DEADLINE : FEBRUARY 15th 2012

- Abstracts must be submitted in English, or French/English, or Italian/English.
- Email your abstract to sfodf@wanadoo.fr to the attention of Marie-Pierryle Filleul.
- Proof read your abstract carefully.
- Title: Limit your title to 10 or fewer words. The title should indicate the content of the abstract in a concise manner.
- Authors and Co-authors: List each author's name including initials (4 authors maximum).
- Institutions: List each institution, city and country of each author and co-author.
- The text of the abstracts must clearly describe the content of the presentation. It could be structured as follows:
 - Objective (Aims): an introductory sentence indicating the objective and purpose of the study
 - Subjects/materials and methods: a description of experimental procedures including applicable statistical evaluation.
 - Essential results including data and statistics, where appropriate
 - Conclusions. Statements like "the results will be discussed" are insufficient.
 - Name of supporting agency and grant number (if any).
- Limit your text to 2000 or fewer characters (approximately 300 words).
- Figures, tables and illustrations may not be included in abstracts.
- Authors must indicate whether or not they or their family members have a financial and/or beneficial interest in any products or services related to their presentation in the abstract form.
- Abstracts will be considered by the scientific committee of the congress and the accepted abstracts will be published online.
- Authors will be notified of acceptance / refusal of the abstracts by February 28th 2012.

- After acceptance, a PowerPoint version of the poster must be send to the scientific committee before April 6th, 2012.

- All abstracts and PowerPoint versions of the poster become the property of congress. Submission of an application to participate represents permission to duplicate, publish and disseminate the abstract. Abstracts could be published in "l'Orthodontie Française" and in "Progress in Orthodontics ».

- Posters must be on display throughout the congress i.e. from 09 :00 hours on Saturday the 28th April to 18 :00 hours on Monday the 30th April, 2012.

- Authors must be present in the poster area to discuss their poster, especially during the different coffee break.

- Poster format: 80 cm (width) x 100 cm (height). To enable delegates to easily read the information the lettering should be a minimum of 1 cm high.

- Only one poster can be submitted by each presenting author for poster Awards.

- All presenting authors must register for the congress and pay the appropriate delegate fees (*see special registration fees for post graduate students presenting a poster*).

- SFODF members may submit their poster to obtain full membership (tabularization).
